About The Program

A Brush with Kindness is a program serving low-income homeowners who struggle to maintain their homes. By connecting people and repairing homes through simple acts of kindness, homeowners can once again live in a safe and decent home.

How We Do It

Greater Fredericksburg Habitat for Humanity identifies struggling homeowners based on their income level, need, and willingness to partner in the program.

Greater Fredericksburg Habitat for Humanity and volunteers help struggling homeowners with home maintenance, which typically includes painting, minor repairs, landscaping, weatherization, handicap ramps, and critical repairs to alleviate health, life, and safety issues.

The homeowners then make low monthly, zero interest payments to Habitat for Humanity which are placed in a revolving fund to

help A Brush With Kindness serve others in need.

Why it Matters

A Brush with Kindness is designed to revitalize the appearance of the neighborhood, encourage connections within the community, and most importantly, help preserve affordable housing stock.
